Steam-Up Swap Meet Rules and Regulations

Show Dates: July 30 and July 31, 2011
AND July 6 and August 7, 2011

Set-Up Thursday-Friday, July 28-29, 2011
9:00 AM – 7:00 PM

(We request set-up by Friday night)

Swap Meet Hours: 8:00 AM - 6:00 PM

Gates open to vendors at 7:00 AM Saturday and Sunday

Note: Vendor pass will be required for entry
on set-up days.

- Guidelines for acceptable merchandise.** In an effort to maintain the quality and presentation of the Steam-Up Swap Meet for buyers as well as other vendors, we are seeking to have vendors that are offering the following types of merchandise: antique tractors, cars, motorcycles and trucks and related parts and literature, tools, primitive American pieces, Americana collectibles and quality reproductions and yard art/old iron; emphasis on original or restored pieces from the 1900's through the 1970's. Swap meet vendors shall not sell food or beverages. If the items you intend to sell are outside these guidelines you are encouraged to ask in advance to avoid any disagreements at the event. Contact Swap Meet Manager Scott Smith at 541-484-6844. Antique Powerland Museum Association reserves the right to request the removal of any items displayed by any seller that the swap meet manager deems inappropriate for a "family-friendly" event. No firearms are allowed to be sold or displayed.
- Vendors camping/sleeping/staying overnight in their booth MUST pay for camping for ALL nights that they intend to spend in their space PERIOD! This includes sleeping in pickups or trailers, and also includes the set up days and the weekdays between show weekends. There are restroom/shower facilities on the Powerland grounds you can use at no additional charge if you are a paid camper. Camping in a swap meet space is \$12 per night in addition to the space rent. Camping outside of the Swap Meet is also available in close proximity, call the Powerland office for details.
- Vendors or campers who are running generators or amplified sound systems may be asked to discontinue use and/or move at the discretion of the show manager.
- All tents, canopies, awnings must be secured to the ground. Vendors shall make reasonable effort to keep their space safe for the public and other vendors.
- Please help us keep the "old-time feel" on the grounds during show hours. Modern vehicles are not to be operated on the grounds during show hours. Vendor parking for transport vehicles and trailers is available to the west of the swap meet area across trolley tracks. All vehicles that are not completely within vendor stalls must be in designated vendor parking area ONLY!
- Vendors will receive two (2) gate passes for their first 20 X 20 space and one (1) pass for each additional 20 X 20 space for each day that they book the spaces. Vendors will need to show a vendor pass for entry on set-up days.
- Cancellation of a space prior to July 25, 2011 will be given 75% refund so long as all gate passes are returned and ONLY IF THE SPACE IS RESOLD.
